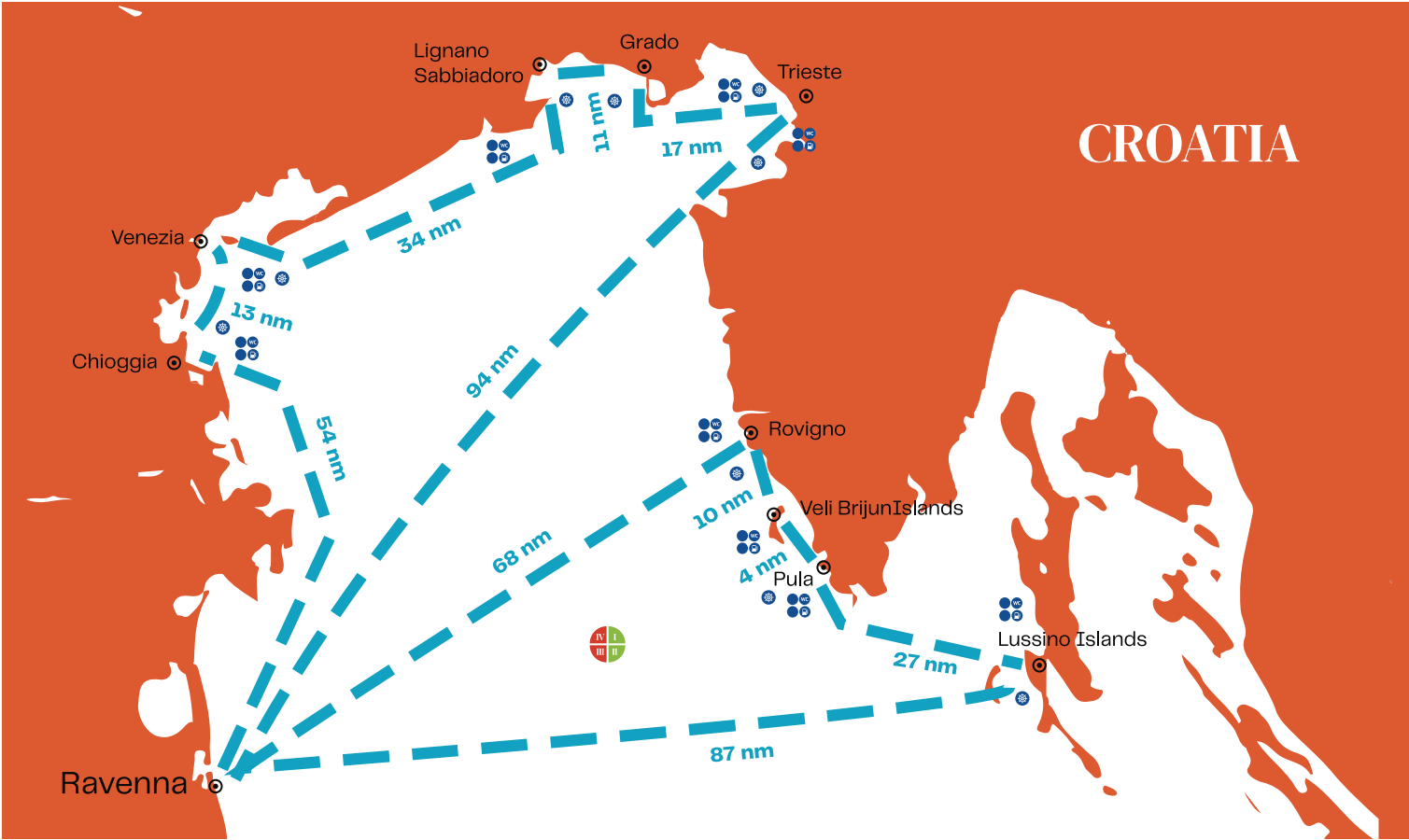

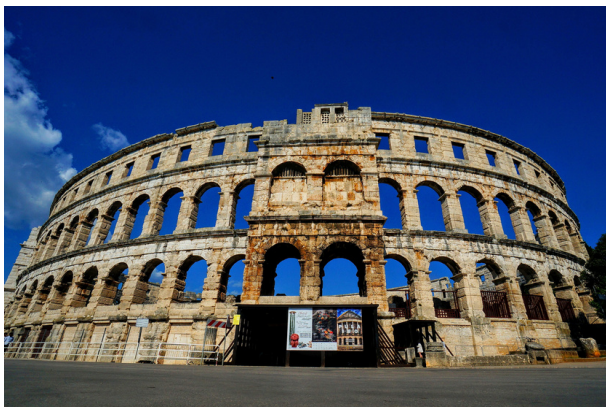
## ISTRIAN ARCHIPELAGO (BRIJUNI ISLANDS)

Brijuni Islands (in Croatian Brijuni) are a green archipelago of islands one mile southwest of the Istrian Peninsula. There are a total of 14 islands, covering a total area of 8 km<sup>2</sup>, and are a true paradise for boaters.



## LUSSINO

The island of Lussino, or Losinj, is located in the Cres and Lussino archipelago, in the northwestern part of the Gulf of Quarnero. The island is very green and covered with lush forest which has led to the creation of a Park including the nearby islands of Unije, Susak, Orjule, Vele and Male Srakane.



## PULA

The city of Pula boasts an important Adriatic port and is famous worldwide for its large Roman amphitheatre, built from Istrian stone by Emperor Vespasian and able to accommodate up to 20,000 people. Departing from our base in Marinara (Ravenna), a stop at Cape Kamenjak is a must on the way to Pula, and then continue to the bay of Portić, a secluded and well-protected inlet ideal for spending a night at anchor.
