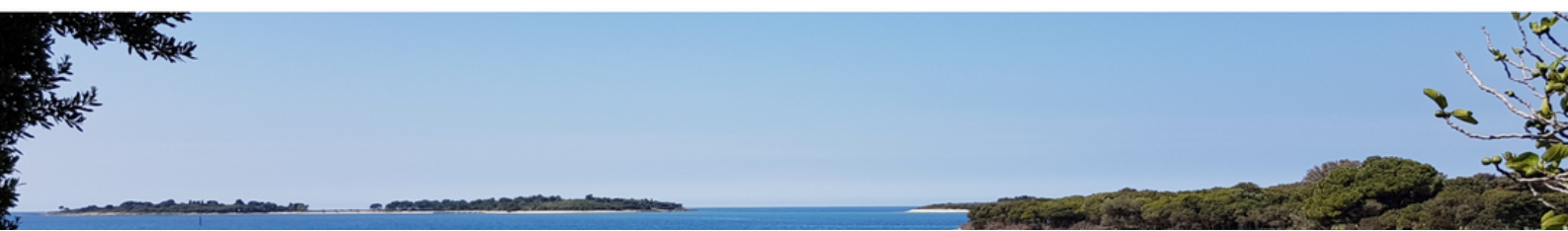

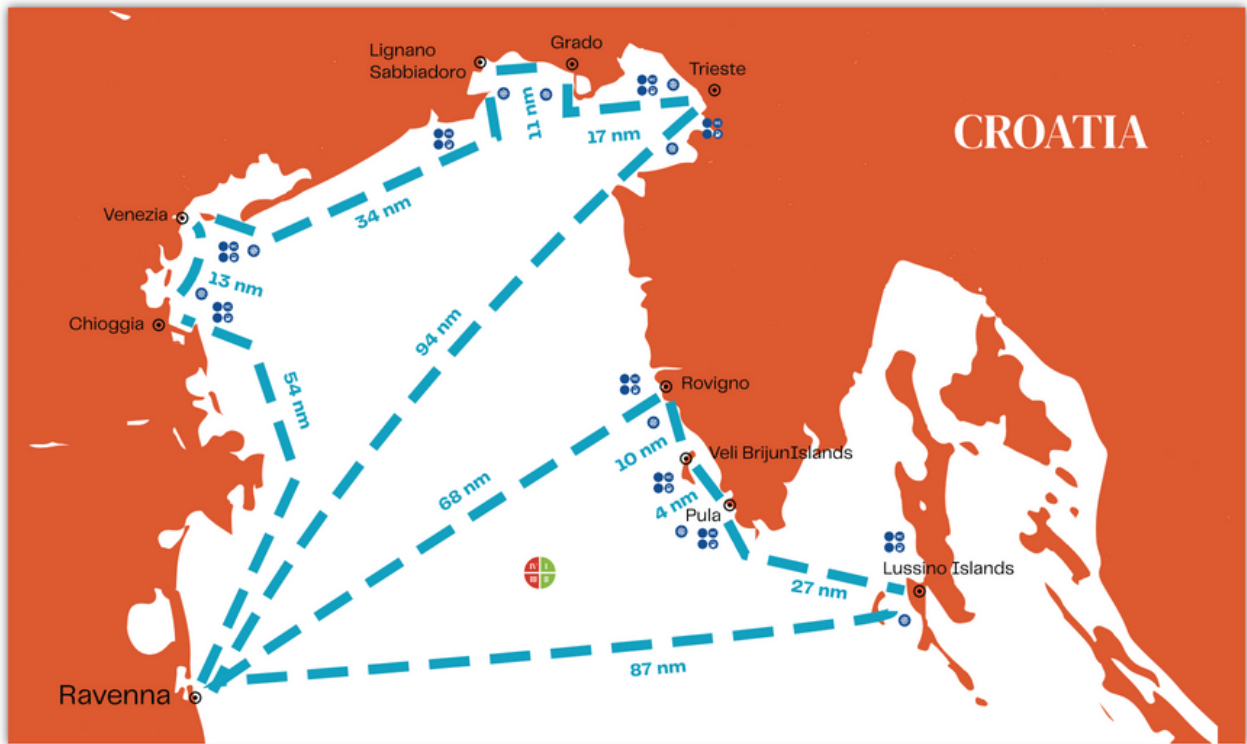

SUGGESTED ROUTES

The tourist port of Ravenna is the safest port on the Adriatic, as well as the best equipped and currently considered the best in Italy.
It is an excellent base for discovering the coast of Emilia Romagna, Veneto, the Adriatic islands and Croatia.



Venice

Starting from the base in Ravenna it is possible to reach Venice and immerse yourself in the magical atmospheres of the canals or sail in the open sea, through the mouths of the Lido, Alberoni and Chioggia.



Croatia and Istrian archipelago (Brijuni islands)

The Brijuni Islands (Brijuni in Croatian) are an archipelago of very green islands one mile south/west of the Istrian peninsula. There are 14 islands in total, covering a total area of 8 km², and are a true paradise for yachtsmen.



Lussino and Pula

Lošinj

The island of Lošinj or Losinj is located in the archipelago of Cres and Lošinj, in the north-western part of the Kvarner Gulf. The island is very green and covered with a lush forest which led to the creation of a park also including the islands close to Lošinj: Unije, Susak, Oržule, Vele and Male Srakane.

Pula

The city of Pula boasts an important port on the Adriatic and is world famous for the large Roman amphitheater, built in Istrian stone by Emperor Vespasian, which could accommodate up to 20,000 people. Starting from our base in Marinara (Ravenna), sailing towards Pula, a stop at Cape Promantore (Kamenjak) is a must to continue to the bay of Portič, a secluded and well-protected inlet, ideal for spending a night at anchor.
