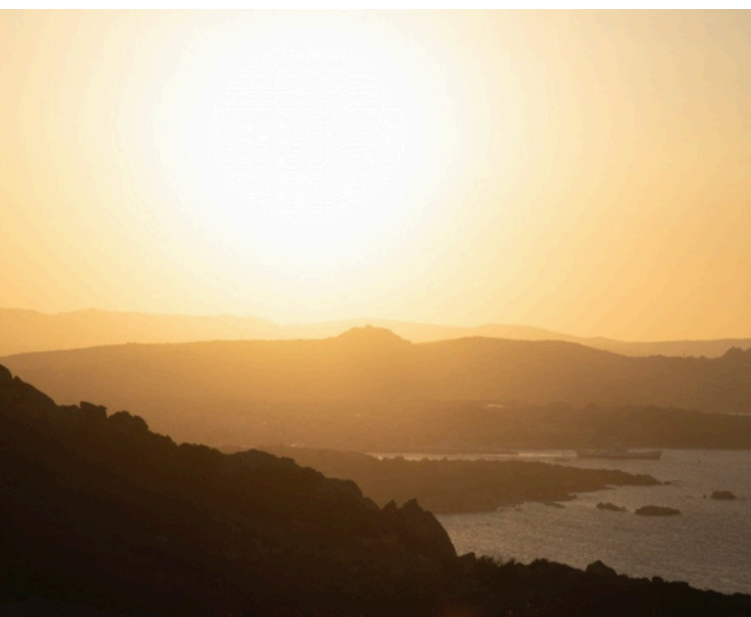
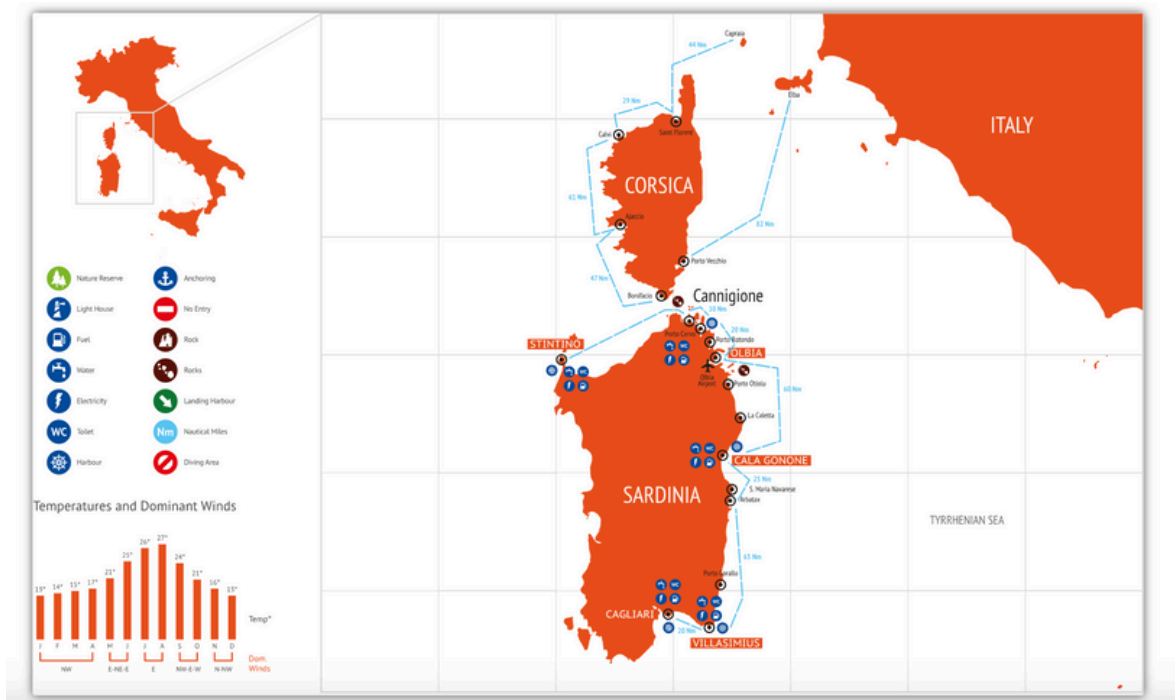

## SUGGESTED ROUTES

Marina di Cannigione, located within the Gulf of Arzachena (province of Sassari) is located in an area protected from all winds, near a splendid village on the sea, at the gates of the La Maddalena Archipelago. From here it is possible to reach the most beautiful places of the La Maddalena Archipelago and Southern Corsica in just a few hours of navigation.



## Cannigione and the Costa Smeralda

Our marina in Cannigione is within the so-called "Costa Smeralda": a splendid coastal area located in the north-east of Sardinia, famous for its white sand beaches and crystal clear waters which make it a very popular tourist destination.

The Costa Smeralda was created in the 1960s by a group of international investors, including Prince Aga Khan, who wanted to create an exclusive place for their wealthy friends. Today, the area has become one of the most luxurious and glam beach destinations in the Mediterranean, attracting many visitors every year thanks to its haute cuisine restaurants, trendy bars and the unrivaled beauty of its landscapes.





## La Maddalena archipelago

From the Marina di Cannigione it is possible to reach the National Park and the Marine Reserve of the La Maddalena archipelago in just a few hours of navigation, famous for their beauty and uncontaminated nature and, renowned throughout the world, for their beaches, clarity and transparency, of their waters, which are reminiscent of the Caribbean ones.

Here are some unmissable places to visit during your sailing adventure.

**Spaggia Rosa di Budelli:** accessible only by sea, this beach owes its name to the characteristic color of the sand, a pale pink due to the grains of coral. An enchanting place to stop, swim in the transparent waters and admire the unique landscape.

**Spargi archipelago:** sailing towards the island of Spargi, stop in the bay of Cala Corsara. This secluded spot is surrounded by towering cliffs and offers a peaceful anchorage. Snorkeling and diving are unmissable here, thanks to the wealth of marine life that populates its seabed.

**Caprera Island:** explore the famous Cala Coticcio, also known as "Tahiti". This hidden bay is surrounded by granite rocks and offers turquoise waters ideal for swimming. A magical place where you can enjoy a peaceful day on the boat and relax on the white sand beach.

**La Maddalena:** the historic center of the city offers a pleasant walk through cobble streets, shops and restaurants. From the port, you can organize excursions to discover the other treasures of the archipelago.



## Southern Corsica

From Porto Rotondo - Punta Asfodeli it is possible to set sail for Southern Corsica.

some of the most extraordinary places to visit in the southern part of this fascinating island.

**Bonifacio:** is a city nestled on the limestone cliffs with a panoramic view of the sea. Its picturesque alleys, old walls and citadel tell millenary stories. Don't forget a visit to the Caves of Bonifacio, a complex of sea caves that reveal the hidden beauty of the Corsican coasts.

**Porto-Vecchio:** famous for its white sand beaches and crystal clear waters.

**Plage de Palombaggia and Santa Giulia** are earthly paradises where you can relax under the radiant sun and swim in a turquoise sea. The streets of the historic center of Porto-Vecchio, with its charming cafes and shops, are also worth a quiet stroll.

**Sartène:** known as the "most Corsican city in Corsica". Its narrow cobble streets, granite houses and vibrant square life capture the essence of the island. Don't miss the traditional Sartène Fair in September, a unique experience to immerse yourself in local traditions.

**Bavella:** Nature lovers cannot overlook the enchanting mountainous region of Bavella. The Aiguilles de Bavella, granite peaks that touch the sky, offer spectacular hikes and breathtaking panoramic views. The Ospedale forest, with its crystalline lakes, is an oasis of serenity surrounded by greenery.
