## Venice

Starting from the Ravenna base, it is possible to reach Venice and immerse yourself in the magical atmosphere of the canals or sail in the open sea, through the mouths of the Lido, Alberoni and Chioggia.



## Croatia and Istrian archipelago (Brijuni Islands)

The Brijuni Islands (in Croatian Brijuni) are an archipelago of lush green islands located one mile southwest of the Istrian peninsula. There are 14 islands in total, covering a total area of 8 km<sup>2</sup>, and they are a true paradise for sailors.



## Lussino and Pula

### Lussino

The island of Lussino or Losinj is located in the archipelago of Cres and Lussino, in the north-western part of the Kvarner Gulf. The island is very green and covered with lush forests that led to the creation of a Park that also includes the islands near Lussino: Unije, Susak, Orjule, Vele and Male Srakane.

### Pula

The city of Pula boasts an important port on the Adriatic and is world famous for its large Roman amphitheatre, built in Istrian stone by Emperor Vespasian, which could accommodate up to 20,000 people.

Departing from our base in Marinara (Ravenna), sailing towards Pula, a stop at Cape Promontore (Kamenjak) is a must, continuing on to Portić Bay, a secluded and well-protected inlet, ideal for spending a night at anchor.
