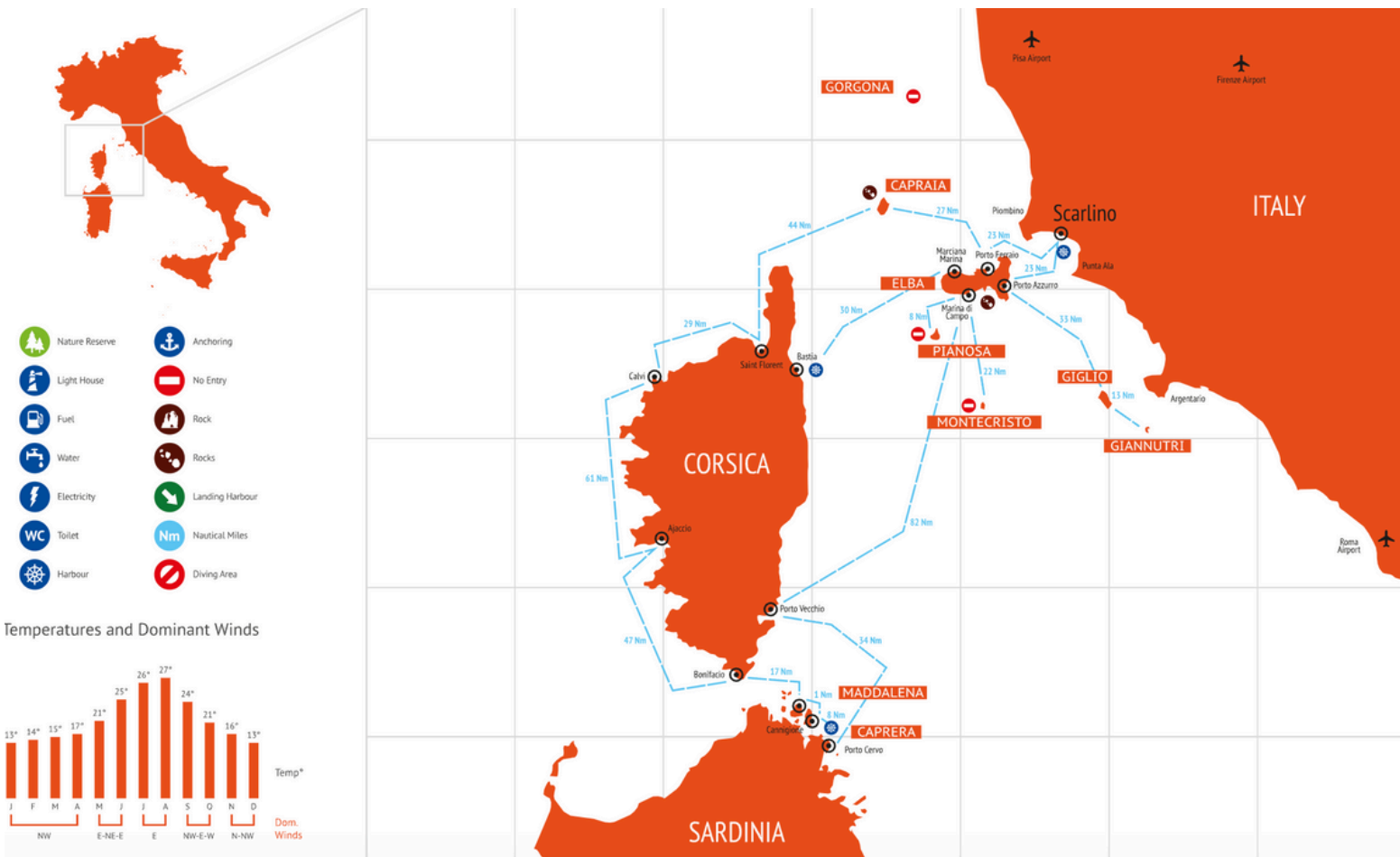
Stop at Follonica, and then take a taxi to reach the Scarlino marina

## SUGGESTED ROUTES

Scarlino, in the province of Grosseto, is a delightful medieval village perched on Monte d'Alma (250 m above sea level) made up of alleys and streets rich in history.

The town also has a modern tourist port (the port was already used in Roman times), equipped with all comforts and services such as clubs, beauty farms, shopping galleries, seaside restaurants and splendid beaches (such as Cala Violina, considered one of the most beautiful in the Maremma).

From our base in Scarlino it is possible to reach Northern Corsica, perhaps after a stop on the island of Elba.



### Northern Corsica

The first port of arrival is Bastia, a small town that can be easily explored on foot in a couple of hours, surrounded by wonderful beaches. From there, continuing towards Cap Corse, we find Centuri, a town where life seems to have remained suspended: a small Port with a few houses around.

This is the wildest and least touristic part of Corsica. Going down the north coast of the island you reach Ile Rousse, "the red pearl" of upper Corsica, a small town overlooking the sea which at sunset is coloured with iridescent purple hues.
